The Snapshot Viewer enables you to view a report snapshot without having the standard or run-time versions of Microsoft Access 97 through Access 2003. Simply navigate to the snapshot you want to access. When I have multiple reports, they all appear in the results. So if I have three reports, I would get three instances of the desired report. Is there a way to only have one show up. I have tried changing the SQL statement to "select * from [table] where [reportName]='abc'" but it just errors out. I'm not really sure if this is the best way to do it, but I am unsure of how to restrict it to one. A: The r_ block is the report's block. The l_ block is the field's block. Try objAccess.DoCmd.OpenReport, reportName,,,, False objAccess.DoCmd.Open

What's New In Snapshot Viewer For Access 2003, 2002, 2000, And 97?

Common Dialog Box Controls The Snapshot Viewer dialog box has the following controls: * **Snapshot:** You can load a snapshot using this control. By default, the name of the snapshot is called `sn_test1` and the folder it is in is called `C:\Demo`. Click the folder icon in the Snapshot control to change the name and the folder of the snapshot. * **File Source:** Click the File Source control to navigate to a file or folder that contains one or more snapshots. You can either select a snapshot file in the File Source dialog box or you can select a folder and then use the **Browse** button to navigate to that folder. * **Snapshot Size:** You can set the size of the snapshot that is loaded into the viewer window. * **Process Control:** You can control the amount of CPU and memory that is used by the Snapshot Viewer. These two controls appear only if you are running the Snapshot Viewer under Windows NT 4.0 or Windows 2000.

System Requirements For Snapshot Viewer For Access 2003, 2002, 2000, And 97:

TIP: If you are new to pixel art, don't worry! Some of the challenges are very subtle so you might need to try a couple of different times.
